FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

- ❑ **When is AIDSWALK?** This year AIDSWALK will be held Sunday, October 19, 2008 at The University of Arizona, just east of Old Main on Central Mall. Registration begins at 6:30AM. For more information on AIDSWALK visit www.aidswalktucson.com
- ❑ **Is there a registration fee?** Yes. There is a \$25 walker/runner and \$15 for youth K-12 registration fee. The registration fee includes a 2008 AIDSWALK T-shirt while supplies last.
- ❑ **Where does the money raised go?** 100% of donations raised at AIDSWALK will stay in southern Arizona to help support critical programs and services for people living with and affected by HIV/AIDS and for people at risk for HIV.
- ❑ **Are the fundraising incentives cumulative?** No, the incentives are as listed. But if someone who raised \$500 prefers a \$250 incentive, they are welcome to trade down. Incentives cannot be traded up, however.
- ❑ **I registered as part of a team, how do the incentives work for that?** Incentives are calculated on an individual basis. If a walker is part of a team, incentives are based on what that individual walker raised, not what their team total is. Some teams may prefer to pool their total, and share an incentive. If this is the case, please speak with Development staff person to verify how this will work.
- ❑ **Can we bring dogs?** Yes! Dogs are welcome. We even offer water and treats for our 4 legged friends. If you are bringing a dog, please make sure they are friendly, leashed, and you are a responsible pet owner by picking up after them.
- ❑ **Is this a family event?** Again, yes! We have all kinds of activities for children and youth including a tattoo booth, face painting, jumping castle, rock wall, sidewinders games, mascots, a children's play area, and we even have a dedicated "stroller parking" area. Please bring the whole family.
- ❑ **What do I need to do the morning of the walk?** If a walker has pre-registered, they just need to show up to AIDSWALK, have some free food, and enjoy the event! Early Check-In is a service offered to walkers to help them avoid registration lines the day of the event.
- ❑ **Are there any other events that I can participate in?** Yes! SAAF has several fundraising events throughout the year, though AIDSWALK is the largest. If a walker would like more information about how to stay involved, please call and speak with someone in our Development Office.
